It’s much less international in style than it used to be, or perhaps the Cabernet over the years has become domestic. **Dense, creamy and beautifully textured in the glass, but in the restrained style that characterizes Querciabella’s wines today, the 2013 is a real winner.** Even at this early stage, it’s all finesse. I can’t wait to taste it with a few years of bottle age.”
