DAINERO 2018 IGT TOSCANA

Castiglion del Bosco's sister property Tenuta Prima Pietra, located near Riparbella and famous for owning the tallest vineyard on the Tuscan Coast, produces the Dainero IGT Toscana 2018. The grapes for Dainero are grown in a well-ventilated vineyard at 450 metres, with a constant breeze from the Mediterranean. Vines are Guyot trained and planted at a density of 9,600 vines per hectare. The soils are a mix of gravel and iron rich clay giving concentration to the wine.
